Surgical Options:

As with any surgery requiring general anesthesia, there are certain risks that serious complications or even death may result. To minimize the risk of such occurrences, we offer the following surgical options:

Age	Anesthetic screening Blood Tests	Cost	Accept	Refuse
Under 3 years of Age	Complete Blood Count (CBC) to detect anemia clotting disorders or infection, ALT (liver), BUN (kidney), Glucose (sugar test)	\$39.85		
3+ Years of Age	CBC, BUN (kidney), ALT (liver), Glucose (sugar) Creatine (kidney), Total Protein, and Alkaline Phosphatase (liver)	\$52.65		
Thyroid Profile	Dogs that are older, overweight, skin problems, poor hair coat, recurring ear infections might have low thyroid levels. Cats that are older, have lost weight, increased hunger but no weight gain, increased thirst, might have overactive thyroid levels.	\$33.85		
Heartworm Testing	Has your dog been tested for heartworms in the past 2 years? Is your pet currently taking Heartgard? Yes/No Even if they are on Heartgard your round Dr. Burk recommends testing every 2 years.	\$22.90		
Leukemia/FIV Heartworm Cats only	Leukemia and FIV (similar to AIDS) are two viruses spread through saliva & blood during grooming or fighting. All cats are susceptible unless vaccinated. Heartworm can affect cats too.	\$29.50		
Microchip ID	Permanent form of identification recognized worldwide.	\$25.00		
Laser Surgery	Less bleeding, less swelling, less pain, less risk of infection. The most progressive technology available for faster recovery time.	\$50.00		

Sometimes anesthesia causes excessive vomiting as the pet recovers. If this happens we will provide medication to reduce the vomiting. There is an additional charge for this injection. The doctor will only administer the injection if necessary.
